Jurnal Bangkit Indonesia

The following are instructions for writing a paper in the Bangkit Indonesia Journal published by LPPM STT Indonesia Tanjung Pinang. The author is fully responsible for the contents of the manuscript written and the manuscript is an article that has never been published. Reference lists are made sequentially starting from 1, 2, 3 and so on.

Title

Title Written in Times New Roman 24pt Font (Max 12 Words)

Author1, Author2, AuthorEtc

1.2 Name of Study Program, Name of College, (if the same, write only once)

The title must be clear, straightforward, short and informative, representing the content of the article, maximum 12 words, 24pt font size, bold and each word starts with a capital letter except conjunctions.

The author's name is written clearly without a title. All author emails are displayed, if the corresponding author is not the first author, an * symbol can be added after the corresponding author's email.

Abstract [Times New Roman 9]

The contents of the abstract must include a summary containing the background, research objectives, methods, conclusions and main conclusions of the writing. Abstract writing in Indonesian is written aligned left and right, after the abstract in English, with one space and one column. The word "Abstract" as the title is written in Times New Roman 9 point font, bold, left aligned, the first letter is in capital letters. Abstract text is written in Times New Roman 9 point font, single spaced, maximum 4000 words. After the Indonesian abstract, write down the keywords of the manuscript, 5 to 6 words/phrases. Then it continues with the main text of the manuscript.

Keywords

Keywords are written in 5 - 6 words/phrases which are a subset of the manuscript title and separated by commas between words/phrases.

Manuscript Structure

The manuscript is written with structure; 1. Introduction, 2. Research Methods (including analysis, architecture, methods used to solve the problem, implementation), 3. Results and Discussion, 4. Conclusion, 5. Acknowledgments (optional) and 6. Reference list.

The INTRODUCTION section discusses a problem as well as the urgency and rationalization of research activities. The problem statement is presented in this section along with its justification. The aims and benefits of the research are presented in the last paragraph of the introduction. intends to conduct a review of similar research that has been published in scientific journals which are used as reference sources.

Research methodology

This section explains the data, research stages and flow, approach, activity plan, scope or object, main materials and tools, place, data collection techniques, operational definitions of research variables, and analysis techniques. The research flow is made in the form of a flowchart or similar diagram that is easy for readers to understand and the letters are clearly legible. Explains the detailed stages of the research carried out, data sources, data processing processes and the results to be obtained. The methodology must be in line with the research discussion and the research results obtained.

Long Script

Manuscripts are written on A4 paper size with a minimum of 6 pages including bibliography, a maximum of 12 pages including tables and figures, 6pt spacing between paragraphs and referring to the writing procedures as presented in this paper.

Results and Discussion

The series of research results are arranged based on a logical sequence/arrangement to form a story. The content shows facts/data and does not discuss the results. Can use tables and pictures but not describe the same data repeatedly in the form of pictures, tables or text.

This discussion section should be written clearly and concisely. The presentation section explains the results of data processing, interpreting findings logically, linking them to other research or relevant reference sources. The advantages and uniqueness of this research emerge compared to other research. The structure of writing results must be in accordance with the research method, so that each step in the method provides results and discussion

Manuscript Layout

An easy way to create a layout is to use this guide directly. Basically it is recommended not to use numbering (1, 2, 3, a, b, c etc.) in manuscript writing, change it into sentences. Avoid using sequential bullets/lists with *, √ and other symbols. Avoid blank parts of the page.

So that the submitted manuscript can be processed immediately by the editor, make sure it is written well, following the instructions in this guide carefully.

Table

Tables should be numbered in the order in which they are presented (Table 1, etc.). The table title is written above the table in a centered position, not bold or colored. The font size used is 8 pt for both table titles and table contents. Tables must be referenced and referred to in the text. There are no plumb lines in the table.

Picture

Figures are numbered in the order of presentation (Fig. 1, etc.). The image title is placed below the image in the middle position (center justified). The font used in the image title is 8 pt. Images should be references and references in the text.

Formula

Formulas are written clearly using equations with index numbers, explanations of formula variables are written in paragraph form, not a list of items.

Program List

The program list and algorithm design are written using Lucida Console font (8pt) with a fixed width

Page Specifications

Use the Times New Roman font type throughout the text, with the font size as exemplified in this writing guide. The spacing is single and the contents of the text or manuscript are aligned left-right (justified). The page size is A4 (210 mm x 297 mm). Page margins are 2.54 cm from top to bottom, left and right.

An easy way to write a script is to write directly in the Journal template.

Conclusion

In conclusion there should be no references. The conclusion contains the facts obtained, sufficient to answer the problem or research objectives (not a further discussion); State possible applications, implications and appropriate speculation. If necessary, provide suggestions for further research. State the conclusion in paragraph form, not in numbering form.

Acknowledgments (if any)

Mention the names of donors and facility providers who help.

Reference

It is recommended to use Mendeley/Zotero tools for referral management. Everything listed in the bibliography/reference list must be referenced/referenced in the manuscript. Minimum 15 main and current references (last 5 years). Written in 8pt font size and using the IEEE citation method.
